Any bank transfer fees must be reimbursed. The entry form must be filled out legibly and completely. All signed entries must be made by post **OR** by **e-mail** and have to be accompanied by a copy of the pedigree.

Stable reservations are to be made along with the entries. Stable fee will not be reimbursed in case of cancellation. Additional bedding and hay may be purchased on the show-ground. Stable equipment must be brought.

If entries are accepted after the closing date, an additional service fee of 50,- € will be charged!

Conditions

Conditions of entry: Open to Purebred Arabians horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entries.

Entry restrictions

- Title Show, A Show, B Show - Gold, Silver and Bronze winners are not allowed to take part in an Amateur Show
- C International Show Gold, Silver and Bronze winners are not allowed to take part in an Amateur Show for the rest of that calendar year and **two** calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category.
- The Handler of the horse must not have been paid for showing, training or producing any horse for a third party. This includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever.
- Horse not to have resided on a professional yard on show or training livery in the current year.
- Horse not to have been shown by a professional handler in the current year.
- Horse not to have received regular training from a professional in the current year.
- Overqualified horses or handlers taking part in this show will be disqualified and liable to pay a fine of €300.
- Amateur shows/classes are not qualifiers for the World Championship, Title or A Shows.

Basic Rules

- 1) The ECAHO show rules and regulations (BB 2024) apply in their entirety.
- 2) On submitting the entry forms, all exhibitors, their agents, and associates agree to accept these regulations and to follow the organizer's instructions
- 3) All exhibitors will accept the judges' decisions, which are limited to this show and based on the judging system laid down in the regulations. The judges are invited by the organizer, are not paid, and are not commissioned by their breed societies.
- 4) The judges' decisions are final and will not be contested. The judges are not liable for any consequences resulting from their decisions.
- 5) All horses must be free of contagious diseases and come from a non-infected stable.
- 6) They must be effectively vaccinated against equine influenza (see ECAHO Blue Book 2024 – IV. Addendum). The equine passport must be presented at the show office. In case of a missing vaccination pass, or any suspicion of contagious disease, the organizer may have the horse examined by a veterinarian at the owner's costs. The organizer is entitled to have the horse

- quarantined according to the veterinarian's decision. It is strongly advised to vaccinate against virus abort. ECAHO Rules for Medication Control (see BB 2023) will apply.
- 7) **!! All horses older 12 months need to be tested for Equine infectious anemia (Coggins test). Test can't be older than 12 months !!**
 - 8) **All horses from EU countries must be accompanied by the Health Attestation, in accordance with EU regulations no.2009/156/ES. Horses from third countries must be accompanied with the HEALTH CERTIFICATE for the temporary admission into the European Union of registered horses for a period of less than 90 days in accordance with Decision 2004/211/EC**
 - 9) **Veterinarian certificates for under/overbite and cryptorchidism** certificates for stallions older 24 months **should be presented** at the show-office.
 - 10) The organizer accepts no responsibility for accidents, illnesses, theft, fire, or any kind of damage, whether to people or to animals and objects, in particular, no third party liability for any damages. The owners of all horses or other animals at the show must have legal liability. Everyone is personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by himself, his associates etc., or his horses.
 - 11) Start numbers will be given out at the show office for free.
 - 12) There will be no compensation for transportation costs.
 - 13) All horses are shown in hand. One assistant handler with a whip from the DC is allowed.

Judging method

Two judges will judge each class independently of each other and without a catalog. Each judge gives **1-10 points with a half points** for the following **9 criteria**: Type (breed and gender), Head (separately), Neck (separately), Body, Legs, Walk (separately), Trot (separately), Presentation (separately) and Cooperation handler-horse (separately). Maximum of 90 points can be given by each judge to each participant. The final ranking will be made by the total results of each participant (highest score is the winner). Class result will automatically become the championship result.

Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places

In the event of a tie in the qualifying places of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for type. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for movement. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his preference.
